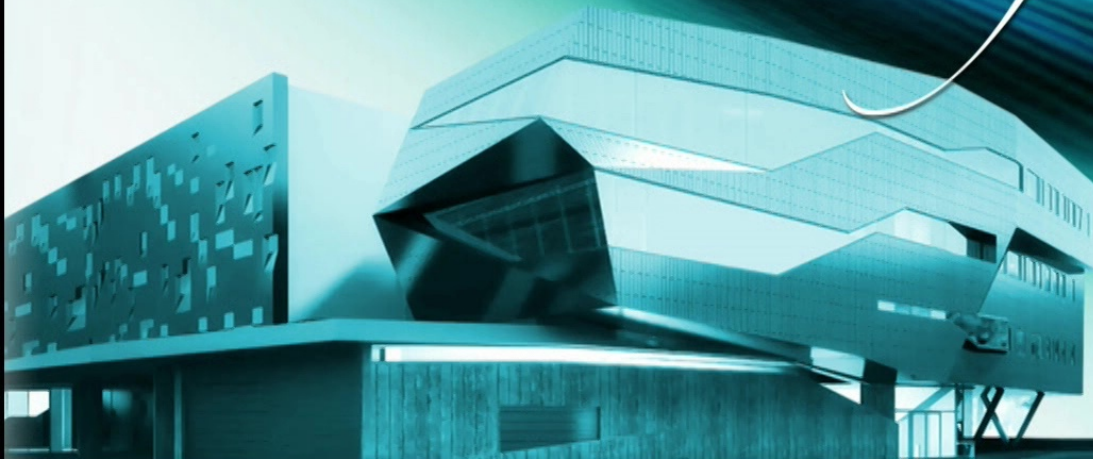

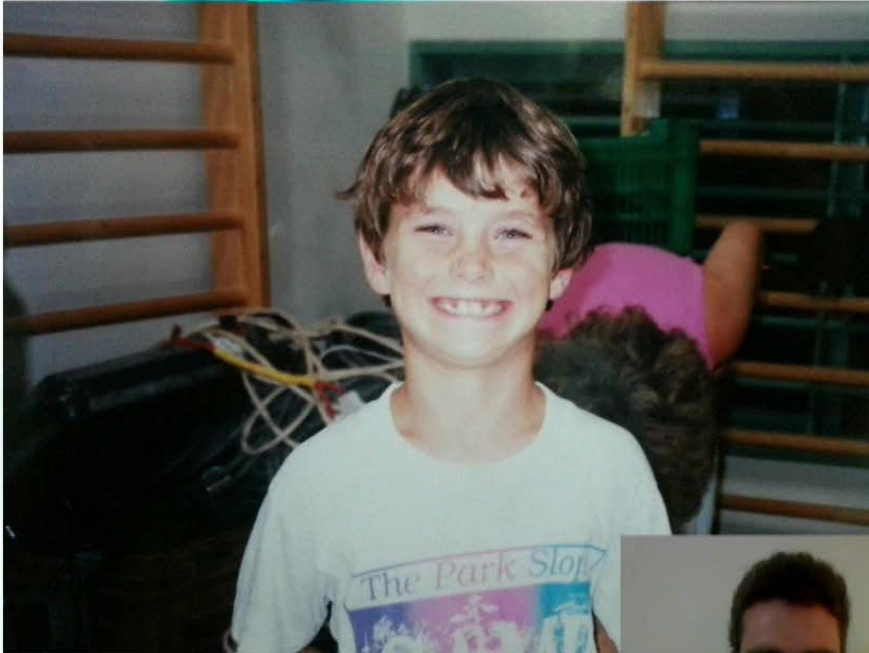

Morten Ib Munk-Nielsen



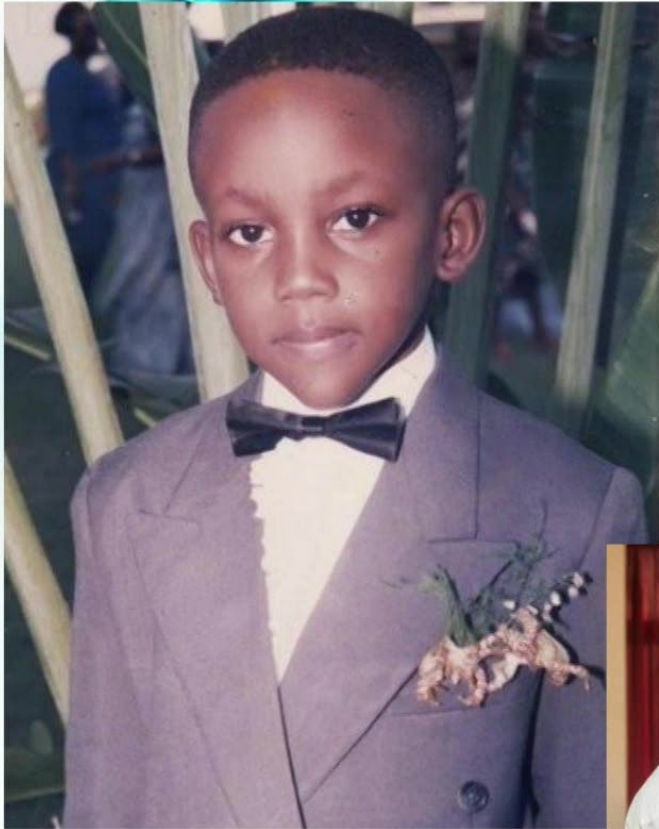
- Denmark

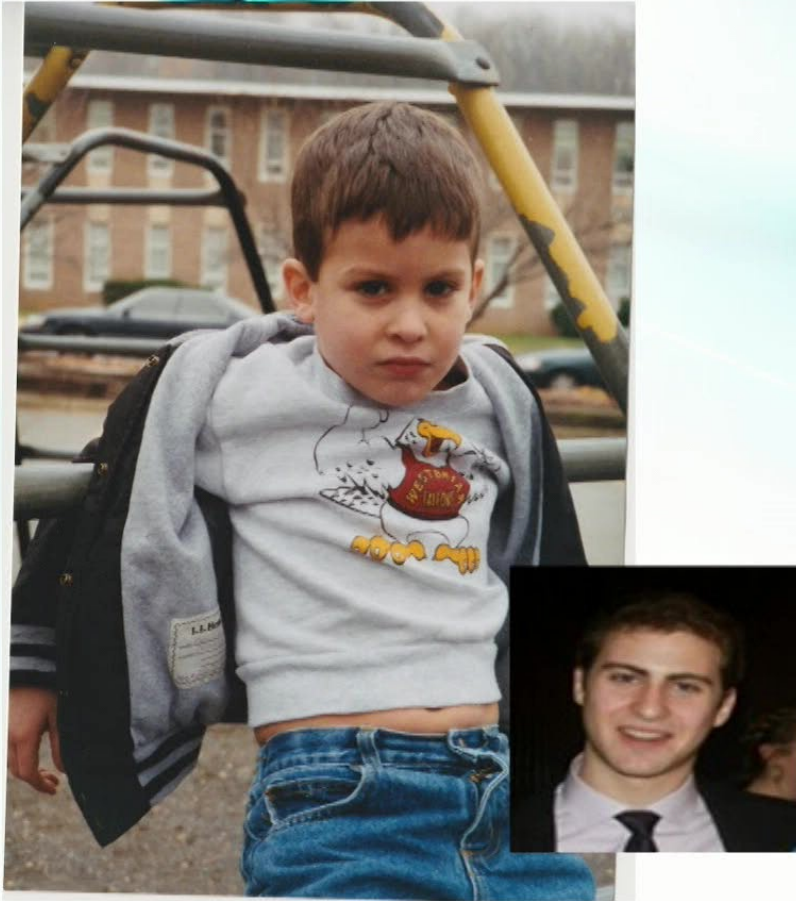
