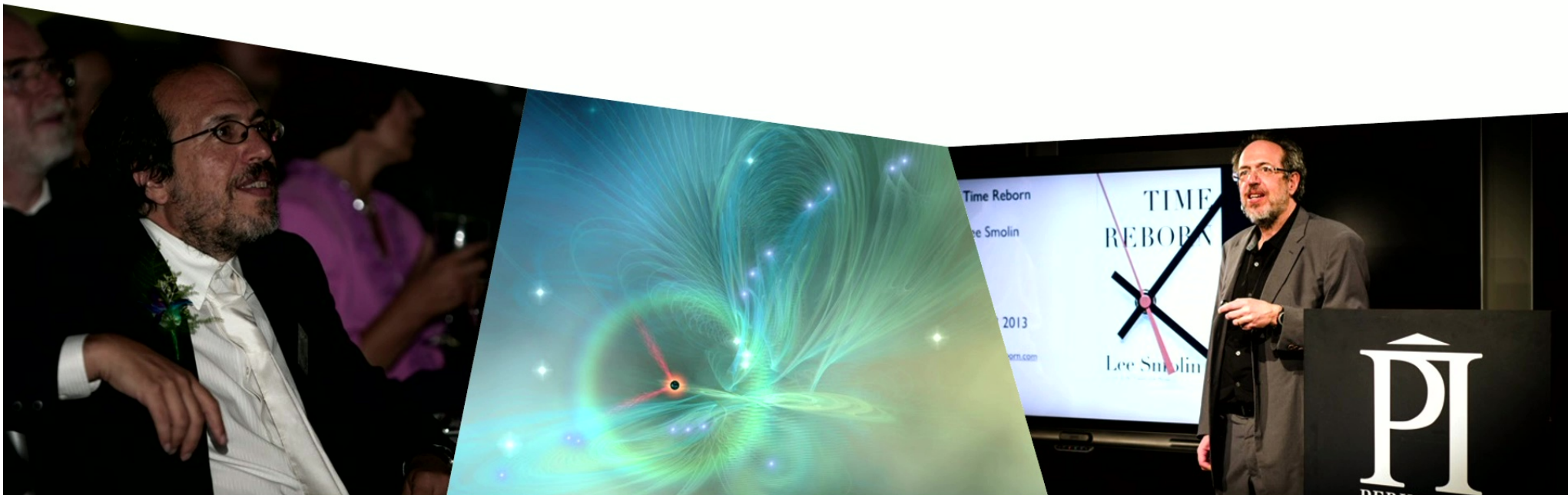

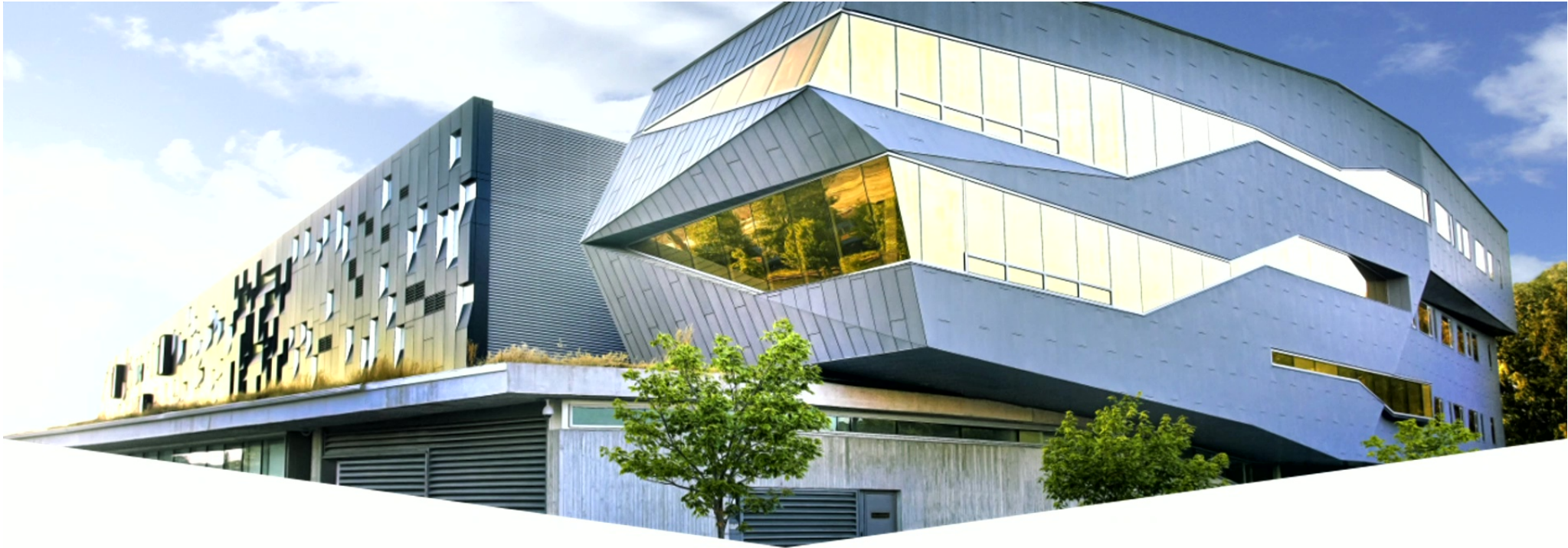

In the past 25 years, the group has trained more than 70+ postdocs and 50+ PhD students

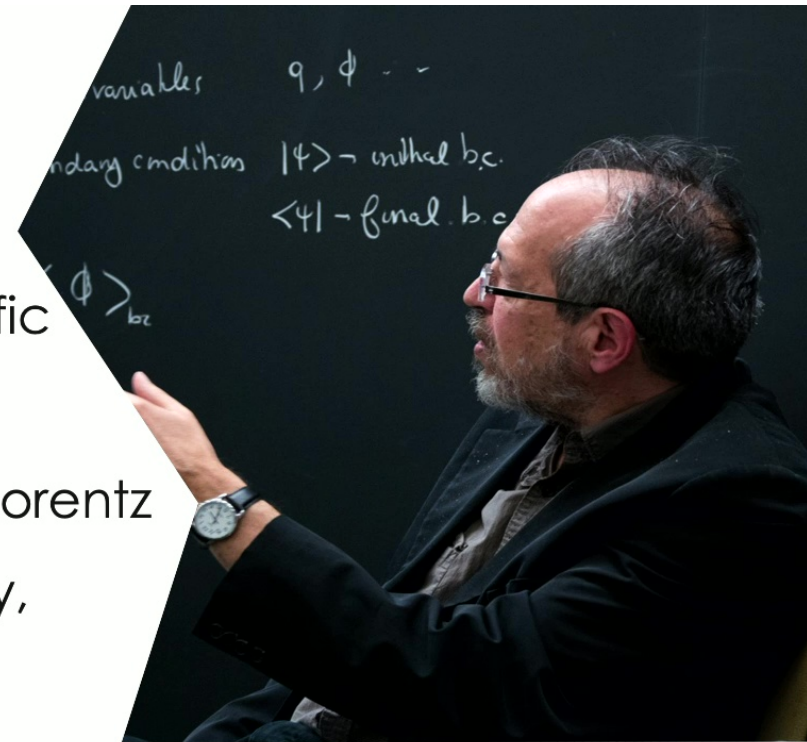
Many of the past PI alumni holds faculty positions. The PI group and Lee's influence has strongly influenced field of quantum gravity. Many of you here have contributed to this success.

A Connector: loop and string, cosmology, biology, philosophy, neuroscience



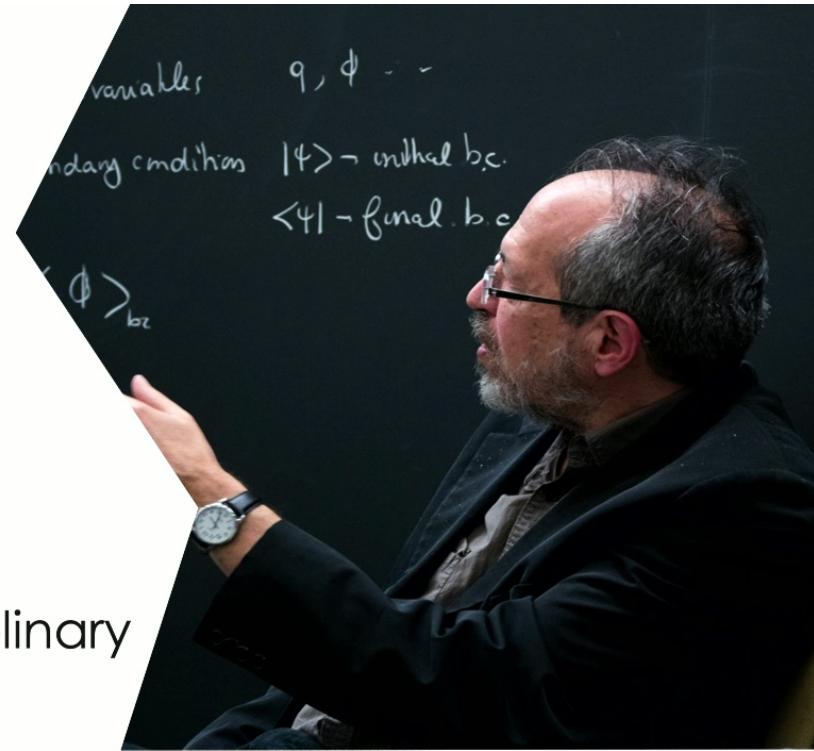
A inspiring colleague
